If you are receiving this email, **you are officially confirmed to attend Gems Camp 2016!** Our Gems Camp Planning Committee has been working hard for the past several months to plan the best Gems Camp experience yet! At this point, you should have received an email from gemscamp@umd.edu with a confirmation packet and more details regarding move-in. If you did not receive this information, please email gemscamp@umd.edu. As you know, attending Gems Camp allows you to move into Ellicott Hall (or another on-campus residence hall) early; therefore, we wanted to provide you with some additional information for move-in day on TUESDAY, AUGUST 23rd:

Please note the following information related to Gems Camp Move In & Departure:

- *If you are living on campus you likely have already received the general move-in informational email from the Department of Resident Life, which lists the move-in date for incoming Honors College freshmen as Thursday, August 25th. **Please note that the Department of Resident Life does not send out special information for Gems Camp, but you will be able to move in on Tuesday, August 23rd anytime between 9am-1pm!** Additionally, you do NOT have to complete an "early arrival" request form.*
- *If you are not living in Ellicott Hall or living off campus, be sure to arrive at the Ellicott Hall first floor lobby **no later than 2:30pm** to check-in for Gems Camp. We depart for camp sharply at 3:30pm, so please be prepared with your bags packed for Gems Camp. You should be able to enter Ellicott Hall by using your university ID card at the back entrance of the building (facing the Diner).*
- *All students attending Gems Camp should report to the Gemstone Suite (Ellicott Hall basement level) at 3pm with camp bags packed and ready for departure!*
